President's Message

Remember last year when the RE kids decorated bowls for us to buy and we had an interesting and surprisingly good Afghan lunch to support the UUSC project to help educate girls in Afghanistan?

We raised over \$900 to support the UUSC effort there.

This year the UUSC has partnered with the Soil Farm Multi-culture Group in Kenyan (multi culture meaning varied crops) to form the Hope in Crops Project to restore the Kakamega rain forest. Years ago the president of Kenya started to cut the forest because he wanted to plant tea. Many people opposed him and were jailed for years. These people are now free and make up the SFMG.

They have partnered with the UUSC to plant trees, help people become self sustaining and educate children. Over 170,000 trees were planted in the first nine months of 2010.

Kenyan children are learning about the importance of the rain forest and are growing seedlings to plant. Hope in Crops is teaching bee keeping and helping people raise cattle for milk. This project is making a difference in restoring this vital rain forest and helping people support themselves.

Our kids will be learning about the rainforest and this project during February. They will have a fund raising project to support Hope in Crops.

We will have a special program Feb. 20, and an African lunch on Feb. 27. This fund raiser Kenyan lunch will be prepared by the RE kids. There will be announcements with details.
